Late night places to eat

Il Tramezzino serves some of the best sandwiches in Beverly Hills. The casual eatery is open for breakfast and lunch, and is also open for a late-night snack on Fridays and Saturdays. Keep things light with a strawberry arugula salad, or go for something more filling like a panini or pasta, especially the penne Milano with its signature pink Alfredo sauce. Open until 4 A.M. Friday and Saturday. Go for the homemade pasta and stay for the people-watching at Il Pastaio. On any given night, the upscale restaurant's romantic outdoor dining space is dotted with VIPs, making dining here quite an experience. Despite its A-lister appeal, this 23-year-old gem is still an old-school neighborhood trattoria at heart. You can't go wrong with any of the dishes on the menu, but make sure to try the pasta or risotto special of the day. Open until midnight Friday and Saturday. Caffè Roma has been serving up Northern Italian cuisine in Beverly Hills for more than 35 years. Its cobblestone patio, piano bar and live music set a relaxed tone any time of day. On Saturday nights, the restaurant gets lively when it transforms itself from a casual eatery into a late night supper club. Open until midnight Monday-Thursday, 1:30 A.M. on Friday, 2 A.M. on Saturday and 11 P.M. on Sunday. In a city like Orlando, you can find delicious food of any kind at all hours of the night. It has locations in SoBo, College Park, downtown Orlando, Winter Park, Lake Mary, Waterford Lakes and New Smyrna Beach. This trusty guide to Portland bars + restaurants open after midnight will help you find that late-night bite in downtown when most spots have already closed their doors. We've narrowed down some of our favorite spots to grab food near Old Town/Chinatown that serve food until 11PM or later, and we've outlined which ones offer veggie + vegan options! Lucky for you, after years of late nights and sudden cravings, we've tracked down some of the best food to feed your soul. You can never go wrong with pizza, especially if it's from Sizzle Pie There's hardly ever a time that pizza sounds like a bad idea. (Come to think of it, is there EVER a time pizza sounds like a bad idea?) Sizzle Pie religiously serves up glorious slices until 3am every night of the week. They're also known for their extensive veggie and vegan pizza options, which is a truly rare find, especially at this time of night! If you find yourself ordering a slice of pizza in any of the local pizzerias and think, "an adult beverage would go great with this slice." Well you're in luck! Sizzle Pie has a full bar connected just around the corner. They will even deliver your slices to you at the bar. With a motto like Death to False Pizza, there's no question you're getting one of the best slices in town. Recommended: The Ol' Dirty. (Veggie + Vegan Options) Tacos and burritos, a quintessential element to post-midnight dining. Santeria is dark, eccentric, and absolutely delicious. If you're in the mood for some of our favorite Portland Mexican food at 1:00am, this restaurant is usually right around the corner from just about anywhere downtown. Recommended: Plato Tinga (Veggie + Vegan Options) o yet, now is the time to start. This Vietnamese noodle soup warms the body and soul, and helps get some of the salts back into your body that have inevitably been depleted by 3am. We love pretty much everything on the menu here, and the fact that they're open later than just about anything is a huge plus. They are a Portland hotspot and a must visit after a day of exploring our beautiful city. Recommended: Tom Yum Pho, Combination Vermicelli Bowl. (Veggie + Vegan Options) Tryst is a highlight of Old Town/Chinatown, tucked away in the ever adorable Ankeny Alley. They serve a wide variety of dishes from various Asian cultures, with an emphasis on Filipino food. They have an amazing happy hour, and a late 1800's inspired space that provides good music, delicious cocktails, and a genuinely relaxing atmosphere. Recommended: Tryst Burger. (Veggie + Vegan Options) See Map With an excellent selection of PNW brews and a deep appreciation of The Dude (White Russian included) this is must check out late night stop. Not to be over looked is their list of Australian influenced bites, and impressive list of weekly events and live shows. This urban-chic watering hole offers the perfect addition to your Portland beer tour. Recommended: Dogs on a Pretzel Bun. (Veggie Options) See Map Le Bistro Montage is located in the heart of the Central Eastside Industrial district, and is dishing you all your cajun favorites! It's a magical experience where finer dining meets the casual local art scene. It's a true Portland staple, with communal tables, cajun comfort food, and an amazing curated wine selection. It's the only spot on this list we tell you not to finish all of your food. That's a weird request, you might be wondering why? Your servers will take your leftovers and create extraordinary tin foil creature art masterpieces for you to take home! **While it is not located downtown, Le Bistro Montage is right across the river and a quick Lyft ride away. Recommended: The Spold Mac. (Picture: Cartopia) Portland's food cart offerings reach far and wide, so it's hard to list the individual carts that will tickle your tastebuds and refuel you after midnight - but after years of being downtown, we know which pods are tried and true. If you're needing something cheap, fast and a little greasy - you can almost always find a taco, shawarma, or the occasional burger cart still blazing away at the following spots: SW 5th Food Cart Pod (Alder St. Food Cart Pod Cartopia* *Cartopia isn't downtown, but it's also just a quick Lyft ride away - and usually the best bet for late-night eats, with some carts open as late as 3am. A Melbourne institution which stays open until 2.30am. 15 Celestial Avenue, MelbourneLate night burgers, steak sandwiches and duck-heart yakitori. 10 Bourke Street, MelbourneSouvlakis served around the clock. 177-183 Lonsdale Street, MelbourneBook a TableWalk down the nondescript staircase and let your eyes adjust. There's no natural light at this bistro - that's why it's so easy to lose track of time. Basement 111 Lonsdale Street, MelbourneServing some of Melbourne's best ramen, 24/7. 225 Russell Street, MelbourneThe full menu of tacos and sides is available until 3am every day. 55 Little Bourke Street, MelbournePork crackling and crispy chicken-katsu rolls served until the early hours. 164 Bourke Street, VictoriaChannelling its predecessor's spirit in the form of pizzas until 3am on Fridays and Saturdays. 52 Lygon Street, Brunswick EastBook a TableHead for Connie's - the inside pizza window that's open until 3am, six days a week. 234A Russell Street, MelbourneAffordable, street-style Thai, from 6.30am to 1am every day (and 3am on Fridays and Saturdays). Basement 353 Little Collins, MelbourneOpen to 3am on weekdays and 5am on weekends for moreish Thai-inspired beer food. Cookie, a floor down, is also open late. Level 2, Curtin House 252 Swanston Street, MelbourneNew York-style slices served on paper plates until 1am on weekdays, and 3am on Fridays and Saturdays. 16 Meyers Place, MelbourneBurgers, birds and fries until 3am on Friday and Saturday. And as a bonus: great tunes. 284 Sydney Road, Brunswick24 beers on tap and pizza until 2am. Yes. 64 Smith Street, CollingwoodCharcuterie and cheese until 11pm; and expert cocktails beyond that. 169 Exhibition Street, MelbourneCheese and hotdogs will keep you dancing till 1am. Levels 1 and 2 31 Tattersalls Lane, MelbourneDon't worry if you're stuck in line - pizza is in the oven till 3am every night. 376 Brunswick Street, FitzroyBook a TableBimbo's sister cooks until midnight. 179 Chapel Street, WindsorBook a TableThis Thai kitchen doesn't shut until midnight (2am on Fridays and Saturdays). 62 Little Collins Street, MelbourneHotdogs, fries and "lavish kitsch" decor. 637 Chapel St, South YarraBook a TableWine and cheese until 3am. Hello. 16 Russell Place, MelbourneExtreme burgers to quash midnight cravings. 34 Chapel Street, WindsorBook a TableDogs to 4.30am on Friday and Saturday. 226 Chapel Street, Prahran Whether you've finished watching one of London's incredible theatre shows or simple feeling peckish come the late hours, London is full of late-night places to eat just waiting to appease those tummy rumblings. Kings Cross Restaurant Bar , Lounge Bar , Restaurant Located a stones throw away from Hanger Lane station, Tigerbay is top dining destination for authentic Lebanese dishes. Open until 2:45 am most days, it's the perfect place to have dinner, cocktails and shisha if you're out late. West London , Acton Restaurant , Lounge Bar Whether you find yourself in Bloomsbury, Euston, Notting Hill or Aldgate, this excellent chain of restaurant-bars offers delicious eats and a great drinks menu 24 hours a day. Located atop the Montcalm hotel in Finsbury Square, Aviary is a stylish rooftop bar and restaurant. Sit on one of their brightly coloured sofas, sip their delicious cocktails and enjoy a view of the City skyline; food is served until 10.30pm, giving you plenty of time to work your way through their seasonal menu. City of London , Shoreditch Restaurant , Restaurant Bar , Cocktail Bar Sometimes you need more than a midnight snack, you need a midnight feast, and that's where Cinnamon Bazaar step in. If you're eating at night in London, then this Indian restaurant will fill your tummy with a whole host of mouth-watering delights, their cocktails are also a pretty perfect nightcap.
