You come to my country, you take my money and you don't even learn my language?This age-old tension over "true assimilation" (an issue that has been raised since the dawn of immigrant ferries to the Angel and Ellis Islands) has rekindled at this time for the very reason that always arises: the shortage of jobs. The feeling that such scarcity is only aggravated by the presence of "immigrants", that is, "the other", "the infectious agent", "the root cause of the problem." The obvious incidence of this being the current sitting president, a final beacon of toxic white (orange) male culture mutated into something even more horrible than we ever thought it could be again in the 1990s.
