In June, Lazarus Chakwera of the Malawi Congress Party (MCP), who led the coalition of nine opposition parties, won the presidential election with 59% of the vote. The elections were well administered, competitive and credible, and the results were accepted by all parties concerned. The dominant democratic progressive party (DPP) is accused of obtaining funding from the ministries of the government, departments and agencies (MDA), including parastatal organizations. In a country where most parties do not have a paid appartent for their affiliation, political parties mention undisputed as sources of their funds.
