A compound noun consists of two words that are put together to create a single noun. One of the words is usually a noun; However, the other word can be a noun, an adjective or a preposition. Examples of each type of compound noun are: closed compound nouns - toothpaste, school house, nouns composed of open bedroom - ice cream, root beer, nouns composed of ifenati coffee table - four doors, nuora-in-law, nouns Compound six-pack can be made up of a noun and an adjective as is the case with the word board. Sometimes the compound noun will not have a noun inside it, as in the word output. Even so, it will still be considered a compound noun, because it took the combination of two separate words to form this new word.
